

Protocol 1: Go Ahead. Connect My Day

✚ Good Morning Holy Spirit

Wash my mind from all the unjust-inordinate images and emotions of the night with:

√ Water of the Word

- “Sanctify them in the truth; your word is truth.” - John 17:17
- “Take the helmet of salvation, & the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.” - Ephesians 6:17
- “Already you are clean because of the word that I have spoken to you.” - John 15:3

We are destroying speculations & every lofty thing raised up against knowing God & we are taking every thought captive to the obedience of Christ.” - 2 Corinthians 10:3-5
