Dynamics Of Kingdom Authority Consider The Birds

Genesis 1:26 (ESV)

"Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness. And let them have **dominion** over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over the livestock **and over all the earth** and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."

Adam & Eve were created in His image, unlike any other part or piece of creation. This is because they were made to have and to hold "dominion" over "all the earth."

The word **Kingdom** means the King's Domain or Dominion. Thus, it is "King – DOM!"

Kingdom means Government.

That being said, listen carefully to this Messianic Prophecy:

Isaiah 9:6-7 (ESV)

"For to us a Child is born, to us a Son is given;

and the **government** shall be upon his shoulder,
and his name shall be called
Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God,
Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

Of the <u>increase</u> of his **government** and of peace(Sholom)
there will be no end,
on the throne of David and over His **Kingdom**,
to establish it and to uphold it
with justice and with righteousness
from this time forth and forevermore.
The zeal of the LORD (YeHoVaH) of hosts will do this."

This is a crystal-clear prophetic utterance that tells us that He not only came in precisely this manner and for these reasons, but also describes Him as the great and glorious King of this Government of His Kingdom.

Yeshua only preached the Kingdom. It is the only message He ever preached. He said, "The Kingdom of Heaven is at hand," meaning that it is here right now, touching your life.

Traditional religion does not preach the Kingdom. They spend their energy begging God to do everything for them.

Please understand that you are made in His image – the image of the King! Every part of creation recognizes you when you talk like the King and walk like the King! Every spiritual power of evil knows it as well.

Ekklesia does not mean church. It never did, and it never will. Ekklesia is the people of the Government of heaven. The people of the Kingdom of Heaven. Ekklesia does not have dominion over people of any kind. Ekklesia are the strengtheners of the Government of the Kingdom of

Heaven. When the Spirit of the King calls them together and they stand with their faith in the Presence of the King, all creation moves according to their will because it is His Will being "done on earth as in Heaven." The Will of the King of Heaven is manifesting upon the earth by the decrees of His sons and daughters who are His image.

The first Kingdom that existed was Elohim's Kingdom of Heaven. He created it and it remains the Kingdom of Heaven in the here and now.

This great Kingdom has powerful dynamics, and the possibilities are endless.

The King/Yeshua explicitly told His disciples to "seek first, the Kingdom."

Matthew 6:33 (NASB)

"But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you."

Luke 12:31 (NASB)

"But seek His kingdom, and these things will be added to you."

In context, Yeshua was confronting their daily frustrations of earthly needs. (Money, food, clothing, wellness, etc.)

We need perspective, attitude, and language, if we are going to experience the Kingdom of Heaven manifest in our lives and in the lives of others around us.

Mat 6:25 –27 (NKJV)

"Therefore, I say to you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or what you will drink; nor about your body, what you will put on. Is not life more than food and the body more than clothing? Look at the birds of the air, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into barns; yet your Heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not of more value than they? Which of you by worrying can add one cubit to his stature?"

Matthew 6:25-27

(LITV Literal Version by Jay Green)

"Because of this, I say to you, Do not be anxious for your soul, what you eat and what you drink, nor for your body, what you put on. Is not the soul more than the food and the body than the clothing? Observe the birds of the heaven, that they do not sow, nor do they reap, nor do they gather into barns, yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Do you not rather excel them? But who of you by being anxious is able to add one cubit onto his stature?"

Stop allowing your "worry world" to measure your failures of the past - the present - and your tomorrows!

Stop and put your trust in your Heavenly Father, Creator, Savior, Gift-Giver, and His providing hand.

Your faith in Him as your supply because of His Kingdom authority (not your own abilities), says that you can:

- STOP when you decide
- STOP set your mind on how your Father, Creator, Savior supplies even the birds
- STOP rejoice in the fact that your Father, Creator, Savior, Gift-Giver will much more supply <u>you</u> with your <u>needs</u>.

Kingdom Authority Expressed

Consider? Yes, Consider:

- "they do not sow,"
- "nor do they reap,"
- "nor do they gather into barns,"
- "yet your heavenly Father feeds them"

Your voice in agreement with the King has His Kingdom authority

- From within the Kingdom we can sow out to creation
- From within the Kingdom we can reap a harvest
- From within the Kingdom we can store and save your seed for the seasons to come
- From within the Kingdom we can always have food on the table, and life happens at the table!

Matthew 26:26-291

"And as they were eating,

Jesus took bread, blessed and broke,

and gave to the disciples

and said, "Take, eat; this is My body."

Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you.

For this is My blood of the new covenant/testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.

But I say to you, I will not drink of this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in My Father's kingdom."²

While "they were eating..." alludes to the feast and the way Yeshua took the bread and wine and prophesied caused the new Ekklesia to celebrate YeHoShua's table at every meal, after Pentecost -Shavuot – Weeks, when they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and the fire from Heaven. It was then that they began taking the Bread and Wine at their meals in the manner of Yeshua (according to history).

Luke 12:22-34 (NASB)

"And He said to His disciples, "For this reason I say to you, do not worry about your life, as to what you will eat; nor for your body, as to what you will put on. For life is more than food, and the body more than clothing. Consider the ravens, for they neither sow nor reap; they have no storeroom nor barn, and yet God feeds them; how much more valuable you are than the birds! And which of you by worrying can add a single hour to his life's span? If then you cannot do even a very little thing, why do you worry about other matters? Consider the lilies, how they grow: they neither toil nor spin; but I tell you, not even Solomon in all his glory clothed himself like one of these. But if God so clothes the grass in the field, which is alive today and tomorrow is thrown into the furnace, how much more will He clothe you? You men of little faith! And do not seek what you will eat and what you will drink, and do not keep worrying. For all these things the nations of the world eagerly seek; but your Father knows that you need these things. But seek His kingdom, and these things will be added to you. Do not be afraid, little flock, for your Father has chosen gladly to give you the Kingdom.

"Sell your possessions and give to charity; make yourselves money belts which do not wear out, an unfailing treasure in heaven, where no thief comes near nor moth destroys. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."
