## Behold The Hand – Behold The Nail

יהוה

Isaiah 56:6-7

*“The **foreigners** who join themselves to **YeHoVaH**,  
To minister to Him, and to love the name **YeHoVaH**,  
To be His servants, everyone who  
keeps from **profaning** Shabbat and **holds fast** My **covenant**.  
I will bring them to My holy mountain  
And make them joyful in My house of prayer.  
Their burnt offerings and  
their sacrifices will be acceptable on My altar.  
For My house will be called a house of prayer for all the peoples.”*

Isaiah 6:1-8 (LITV)

*“In the year that King Uzziah died,  
then I saw the Sovereign (Adonai) sitting on a throne,  
high and lifted up. And His train filled the temple.*

*Above it stood the seraphim<sup>1</sup>.  
Each one had six wings; with two he covered his face;  
and with two he covered his feet; and with two he flew.*

*And one cried to the other and said,  
Holy, holy, holy is  
**YeHoVaH** of Legions of Heaven,  
all the earth is full of His glory!*

*And the foundations shook from the voice of the one who cried,  
and the house was filled with smoke.*

*Then I said, Woe is me! For I am cut off;  
for I am a man of unclean lips, (figure of speech)  
and I live amongst a people of unclean lips;  
for my eyes have seen the King, **YeHoVaH** of Legions of Heaven.*

*Then one of the seraphs flew to me  
with a live coal in his hand,  
snatched with tongs from the altar.*

*And he touched it on my mouth,  
and said, See, this has touched your lips;  
and your iniquity is taken away,  
and your sin is covered.*

*And I heard the voice of **YeHoVaH**, saying,  
Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us?  
Then I said, Behold me. Send me!”*

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<sup>1</sup> Seraph is the Hebrew word meaning Fire. The ending of “im” means plural.  
*Fires of Revival*

- Fire is a known foundational manifestation of revival
- Pentecost, Feast of Weeks, Savuot
- Mount Sanai when the Word was first inscribed Savuot
- Here in the Prophecy of Isaiah as the fire is in the Presence and the Seraph (fire)

שָׂרָף

Hebrew: saraph, meaning fire – Seraphim is plural

By this, we prophecy of Isaiah, we find the beginnings of an earth-changing revival that starts from a fire in the Presence that cleanses the speech and obliterates past iniquities and all sin.

This Prophecy is a view of the Messiah's Ministry that YeHoShua HaMeshiach initiated, from the cross of His sacrifice.

Shavuot is a remembrance of the Fire of His Presence

Hebrews 12:18-19 (LITV)

*“For you have not drawn near to the mountain being touched, and having been lit with fire, and to gloom, and darkness, and tempest, and to a sound of trumpet, and to a voice of words, which those hearing begged that not a word be added to them...”*

Hebrews 12:18-19 (The Scriptures [ISR 1998])

*“For you have not drawn near to a mountain touched and scorched with fire, and to blackness, and darkness and storm, and a sound of a trumpet, and a voice of words, so that those who heard it begged that no further Word should be spoken to them...”*

Yeshua, enthroned in heaven, is seen with the fire of His Presence.

2 Thessalonians 1:7 (NASB)

*“And to give relief to you who are afflicted  
and to us as well when the Sovereign Yeshua  
will be revealed from heaven  
with His mighty angels in flaming fire...”*
